

In support of the National Day of Prayer for Survivors of Abuse in a season of hope and new life the Catholic Diocese of Northampton is holding an event at St Teresa's Church in Beaconsfield at 40 Warwick Road, Beaconsfield, HP9 2PL between the 17th and 20th May.

You are warmly invited to join Bishop David Oakley and Bishop Alan Wilson, Anglican Bishop of Buckingham for our opening service on 17<sup>th</sup> May when a LOUDfence will be launched.

LOUDfence is a survivor-led initiative and involves tying colourful ribbons and messages as a visible display of support and solidarity with those affected by abuse.

The LOUDfence will be available on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> May between 9am and 7pm outside of the Church, which will be open for anyone seeking quiet time and reflection. A mixed team of lay and clergy volunteer listeners and welcomers will be available, as well as members of the Diocesan Safeguarding Team should anyone wish to talk.

The LOUDfence will then conclude on the morning of  $20^{\rm th}$  May with a closing service, refreshments and include information from support charities.

Everyone is welcome to join our event which seeks to provide an opportunity for people to gather collectively in support of those who have been impacted by any form of abuse, whether Church related or externally.
