

The Diocese of Northampton is delighted to announce a special pilgrimage to France, led by Bishop David Oakley, from Sunday 19th to Friday 24th October 2025.

The pilgrimage marks the 350th anniversary of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St Margaret Mary Alacoque in Parayle-Monial between 1673 and 1675.

Pilgrims will journey through several sacred sites in France, each rich in Catholic heritage and spirituality. Highlights include:

- Paray-le-Monial: The site of the Sacred Heart apparitions, including visits to the Chapelle des Apparitions and the relics of St Margaret Mary.
- Nevers: Home to the incorrupt body of St Bernadette Soubirous, visionary of Lourdes.
- Ars-sur-Formans: Visiting the shrine of St John Vianney, patron saint of parish priests.
- Cluny: The heart of medieval monastic reform in the West.
- Taizé: The world-famous ecumenical community known for prayer, silence, and reconciliation.

### Corpus Christi Sunday - Reflection

From Fr Biju's desk... Corpus Christi Sunday is the celebration of the abiding presence of a loving God as Emmanuel—God with us—in order to give collective thanks to our Lord for his living with us in the Eucharist. The feast also gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of the "Real Presence" on Jesus — Body and Blood, Soul, and Divinity under the appearances of bread and wine — so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better and receive maximum benefit from the Eucharist.


#### We believe in the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist because:

- Firstly Jesus promised it after miraculously feeding the 5000.
- **Secondly** Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist during his Last Supper.
- Thirdly Jesus commanded his disciples to repeat it in his memory.
- Finally we know that "Nothing is impossible for God.

We explain the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, by transubstantiation which means that the substance of the consecrated bread and wine is changed to the substance of the risen Jesus' glorified Body and Blood by the action of the Holy Spirit, and its accidents like colour, shape, taste etc., remain the same.

Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist both as a *sacramental banquet* and a sacrificial offering. As a Sacrament, the Eucharist is a visible sign that gives us God's grace and God's life and, as a Meal, the Eucharist nourishes our souls. As a sacrifice, the Eucharistic celebration is a re-presentation or re-enactment of Jesus' sacrifice on Calvary, completed in His Resurrection. We offer Jesus' sacrifice to God the Father for the remission of our sins, using signs and symbols.

Every time we come and participate at the Holy Mass, let us all renew our faith and commitment to the Lord in what He has shown and given us through the Most Holy Eucharist. And let us be the worthy bearers of His truth and love by living our lives in the manner that He has taught us to do, now and always. Amen
